The needle up and down function allows you to stop the needle while in either the up or down position, which makes it much easier to turn and rotate corners. Needle position adjustment allows you to move the needle from left to right, which is very useful when top stitching or inserting zips. Computerized sewing machines allow you to sew a button in one step without rotating the piece of clothes around halfway through. Of course, it's worth testing this feature to make sure it functions as promised. Printer foot. Is the foot pedal of a decent size? Is it responsive to pressure and has it an anti-slip base? Lighting. Check the machine's task lighting so you can be sure you can clearly see what you're sewing. Also look how easy it is to change the light bulb – it's quite a complicated task on some models. Case. Look for a heavy case that will ensure that your machine will not wriggle and wobble when in use. At the same time, make sure it's light enough to be easily moved when needed. Free arm capability. Being able to switch to free arm sewing makes it much easier to tackle tight and round portions of dust such as sleeves and pants shirts. Noise. Noise is a factor many people don't consider when buying a sewing machine, but it can be a dealbreaker if the only time you get to sew is late at night when the kids are in bed and silence is golden. Guarantee. Check the length of the guarantee, which covers it and which is excluded. Also, look what the policy is on repairs – is there an in-store service or will your machine need to be sent back to the manufacturer or a repair center should go something wrong?
